- Personnel exchanges, international conferences, and seminars on Japan-related issues
- Performances and/or exhibitions on Japanese culture and art
- Japanese language-related activities
- Japan-related research in humanities and social sciences
- Activities dedicated to promoting greater understanding of Japan

Applicant Eligibility

Individuals and organizations are eligible to apply. Recommendation letter by an expert is required.

Application Period

Nov. 1st – Dec.22th for the grant to be awarded in the following year

Amount of Grant

Grants from ¥ 100,000 – 500,000 will be awarded for projects to be conducted from April 1st – March 31st the following year.

Application Process

Application should be made with a form specified by The Foundation and should include the following:

- Applicant name
- Project outline and budget
- Reference materials about Applicant's past activities
- Letter of recommendation including the recommender's name and title.

Selection Process

Screened by the Selection Committee and approved by the Foundation Board sometime around mid-March.
